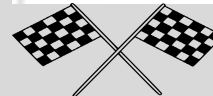

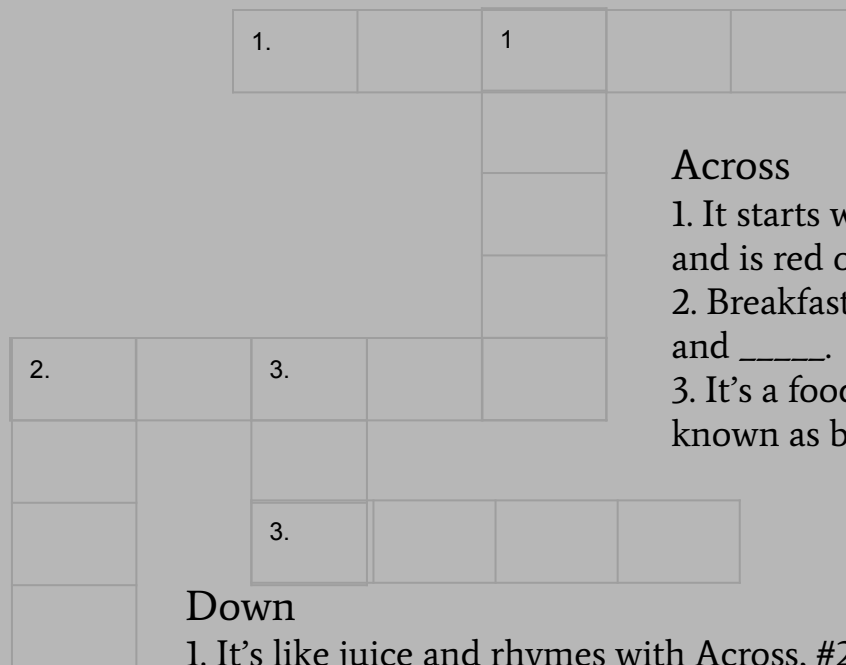
Brain Puzzles

“Okay... But I still have more questions. First, how do you like jumping in human bodies like monkeys?”

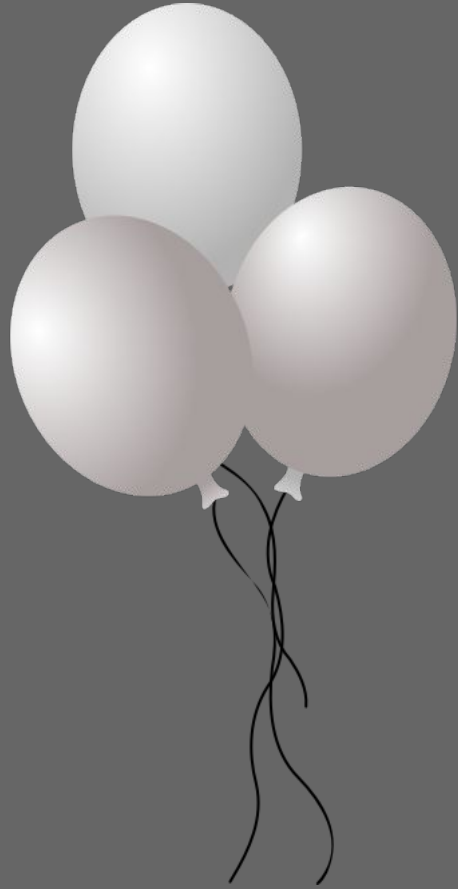
Corona replied, “I’m not a monkey. I have a extremely complicated process. First, I shape myself into a key that fits all the locks on you.”
